
FLW REGION MILITARY SPOUSE EMPLOYMENT NEEDS SURVEY RESPONDENT FEEDBACK

GENERAL BACKGROUND


Using the 2020 U.S. Department of Defense Demographics Report, our data regarding service member rank and military spouse gender are in line with the overall demographic data of the military population. Our respondents provided insight into their backgrounds, including many of their talents. Of all respondents, 54 acknowledged that they speak a foreign language. Top languages spoken include Spanish, German, and French. Of the 327 respondents, 171 acknowledged they had children under 12 living in their homes.



REGIONAL LABOR FORCE COMPARISON

Of those who responded, 66% are currently employed and 34% are not employed. From the unemployed pool of respondents, 37.9% are not currently seeking employment. The data we collected determined that the unemployment percentage of respondents was 16.2%. The 2020 Census determined that the percentage of persons ages 25+ holding a bachelor's degree in the Fort Leonard Wood Region was:

Laclede: 15% | Phelps: 29.9% | Pulaski: 27.7% | Texas: 14.8% In comparison, 56.6% of our survey respondents held a bachelor's degree or higher with 21.2% holding a graduate degree or higher.



PROFESSIONAL DESIRES

The majority of survey respondents who indicated that they were unemployed told us that they desire to work in government service or in the private sector. Fewer respondents were interested in entrepreneurship, contract work, and non-appropriated fund work. Out of the 103 respondents who provided feedback, 47.6% are looking for full time work and 39.9% are looking for part time work.


When asked about EMPLOYMENT SERVICES,
